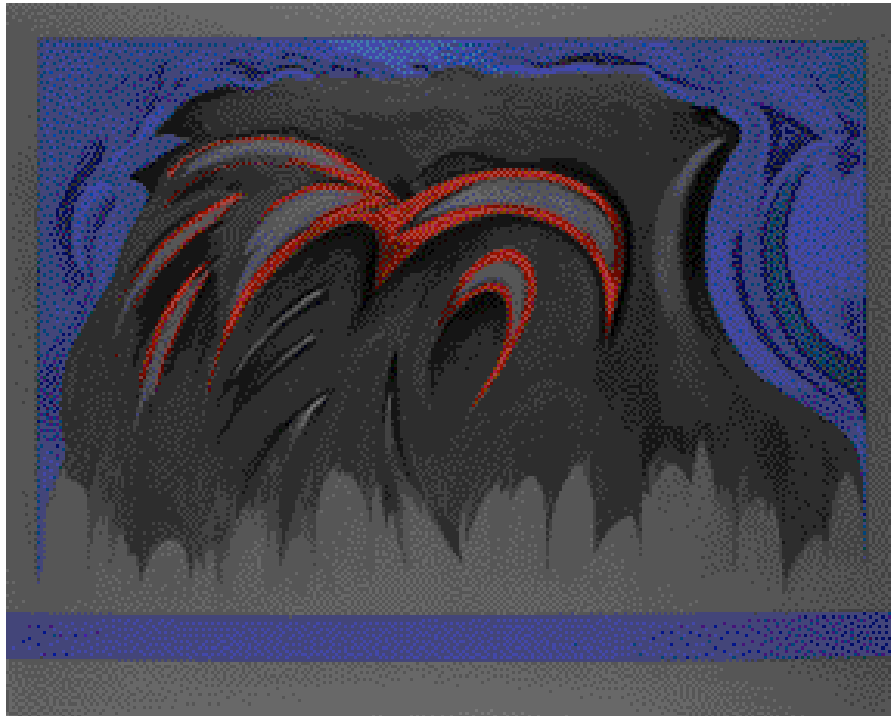
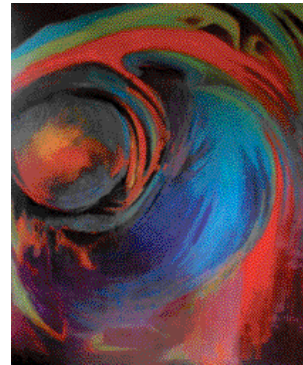


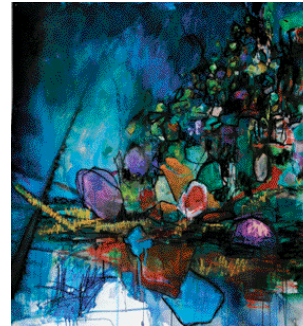

SONIA GECHTOFF "Hudson Gulls", Acrylic on canvas, 2009 48" x 60"



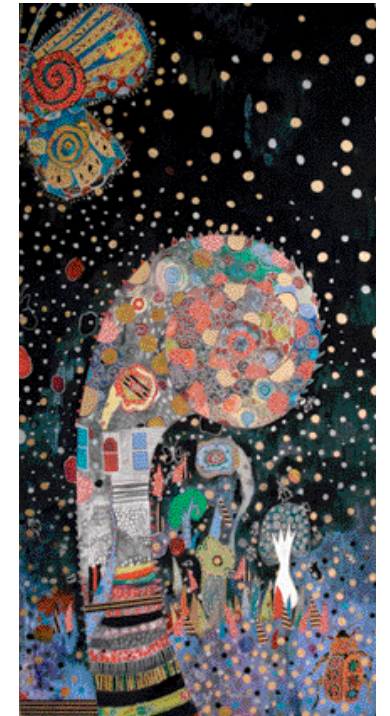
